GRS Laboratories examined a 6.06 ct natural ruby, described in report number GRS2021-060003, that demonstrates very good characteristics worthy of a dedicated mention.


This important ruby is distinguished by a rare combination of size above 6 ct, a fine vivid red color variety, brilliant color reflections, and well-balanced proportions.

Analytical and advanced testing traces the origin of this gemstone to the mines of Mozambique, the mining area currently producing the largest and most significant rubies. The fascinating internal world of classic Mozambican ruby inclusions can be clearly witnessed in this particular gemstone. At the time of testing, it was concluded that the gemstone was spared of thermal enhancement.

This vivid red Mozambique ruby is reminiscent in color saturation of "GRS-type pigeon blood ruby" (without strong fluorescence).

The combination of very good attributes that this ruby displays was concluded to be important. A high degree of lapidary craftsmanship adds value to the nature of this gemstone.

Untreated rubies of this size and high quality are rare.

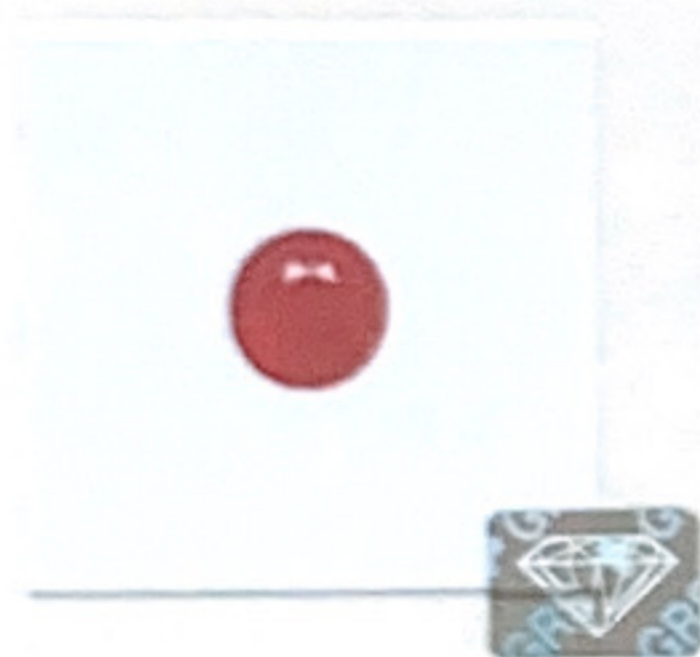
